("NPG") are parties to that certain Credit Agreement ("OpCo Credit Agreement"), dated as of March 8, 2007, by and among the Member and Levlad, LLC, as borrowers, Arbonne Intermediate Holdco, Inc. ("Arbonne HoldCo") and Levlad Intermediate Holdco, Inc. ("Levlad HoldCo"), as guarantors, the lenders party thereto (the "OpCo Lenders"), Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce as administrative agent and collateral agent, CIBC World Markets Corp. and Credit Suisse Securities (USA) LLC as joint lead arrangers and joint bookrunners, Credit Suisse as syndication agent, and Freeport Financial LLC and General Electric Capital Corporation as co-documentation agents;

WHEREAS, certain subsidiaries of NPG are parties to that certain Credit Agreement ("HoldCo Credit Agreement"), dated as of June 19, 2006, by and among Arbonne HoldCo and Levlad HoldCo, as borrowers, and the lenders party thereto (the "HoldCo Lenders"), Wilmington Trust FSB, as successor in interest to Credit Suisse, New York Branch as administrative agent, Credit Suisse Securities (USA) LLC and CIBC World Markets Corp. as joint lead arrangers and joint bookrunners, CIBC World Markets Corp. as syndication agent, and CitiCorp North America, Inc. and UBS Securities LLC, as co-documentation agents;
