("Arbonne HoldCo") and the Company, as guarantors, the lenders party thereto (the "OpCo Lenders"), Canadian Imperial Bank of Commerce as administrative agent and collateral agent, CIBC World Markets Corp. and Credit Suisse Securities (USA) LLC as joint lead arrangers and joint bookrunners, Credit Suisse as syndication agent, and Freeport Financial LLC and General Electric Capital Corporation as codocumentation agents;

WHEREAS, the Company is party to that certain Credit Agreement ("HoldCo Credit Agreement"), dated as of June 19, 2006, by and among the Company and Arbonne HoldCo, as borrowers, and the lenders party thereto (the "HoldCo Lenders"), Wilmington Trust FSB, as successor in interest to Credit Suisse, New York Branch as administrative agent, Credit Suisse Securities (USA) LLC and CIBC World Markets Corp. as joint lead arrangers and joint bookrunners, CIBC World Markets Corp. as syndication agent, and CitiCorp North America, Inc. and UBS Securities LLC, as co-documentation agents;
