**RESOLUTION OF THE
BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF
STONE SURFACES MD, INC.**

A special meeting of the Board of Directors of Stone Surfaces MD, Inc. was held on the 8th day of January, 2010 at Stone Surfaces MD, Inc. offices. All members of the Board were present. The special meeting was called by Kourush Afsharjavan, President to discuss the financial condition of the Corporation and consider the filing of a Chapter 11 Petition in Bankruptcy. After a review of the finances of the Corporation, a motion was made and unanimously approved authorizing the filing of a Chapter 11 Bankruptcy Petition in the United States Bankruptcy Court for the District of Maryland. The President of the Corporation, Kourush Afsharjavan, shall be authorized to execute such documents and complete such accounts as may be necessary to file said Petition.
