FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Managers be, and each of them hereby is, authorized and empowered to execute and deliver and file or cause to be filed with the Bankruptcy Court, on behalf of the Company, a voluntary petition of the Company pursuant to Chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code and any and all other documents necessary or appropriate in connection therewith, each in such form or forms as the Managers so acting may approve;
